

CANADA SETS ALIENS FREE

Allows Germans and Austrians to Go to work On Farms and in Factories

Ottawa, July 15.—Numbers of Canada's interned aliens are now being released.

Between 13,000 and 12,000 aliens and Austrians have been allowed to leave Spirit Lake, Que., and Kaspuskasing, Ont., the large camp along the N. T. R. line, where there are now less than a hundred aliens.

The reason for the release of the men is the great improvement in employment conditions in Canada in factories and on farms.

Complaints as to the treatment of aliens at Kaspuskasing, Spirit Lake, and other such camps, have been received. The Government was able to assure the United States consul that they were unfounded.
