

TRANSFER GERMANS TO MORRISEY CAMP

Major Coleman, Commandant of Brandon internment camp, left for Morrissey, B.C., yesterday, in charge of ninety-three German prisoners, who are being transferred to that camp. He was assisted by Capt. Lambkin, transport officer, Ottawa, and Captain Rigg, of Prisoners of War Guard, Brandon. The camp here is now reduced to a little over one hundred Austrians, many releases on parole to railroad employment having been lately effected.
