

ALIEN ENEMIES IN CANADIAN FORCES

Orders Issued Warning Recruiting Officers to Keep Eyes Open

MUST INQUIRE CLOSELY

All Details To Be Taken When There is Any Doubt of Nationality

Camp Borden, July 24.—The following was in camp orders on Saturday: "Numerous cases have been reported that alien enemies have enlisted in the C. E. F., representing themselves as Serbians or Rumanians. Owing to the great difficulty in determining the nationality of a great many foreigners, it is hereby notified for the information of all recruiting officers and commanding officers that whenever there is any doubt as to the nationality of foreigners when they offer themselves for enlistment, such cases should be referred to the Superintendent of Immigration through this office.

"It is important that the man's correct name, age, date of arrival in Canada, the name of the port of entry (whether Canadian or American), the name of the steamship, and as nearly as possible the date of arrival, should be furnished. All such cases will be investigated by the Superintendent of Immigration before such enlistment is carried out."
