

Spying Aliens Enlisted In This District

Heads of Battalions in Military District No. 10 Warned to be on Lookout for Them

Winipeg, Aug. 2.—That spying aliens have enlisted in overseas units in Military District No. 10 through misrepresentations and that further stringent efforts will be made to prevent this occurring in the future, is the information contained in an order issued by the military headquarters Tuesday morning.

The order warns all lieutenant-colonels of battalions to be on the alert for these men. In the event of a man being under suspicion, the following details concerning his past will be required:

1. Exact name.
2. Age.
3. Date of arrival in Canada.
4. Name of port of arrival, whether in Canada or United States.
5. Name of steamship, and, if possible, the exact date of its arrival.

This information will be tabulated and forwarded to the Department of Immigration in order that the man's antecedents may be investigated.
