

ENLISTED ALIEN ENEMIES

REGULATIONS ON THE SUBJECT ISSUED IN ORDERS

Many Cases Have Been Reported and Immigration Department is to Assist Recruiting Officers to Securing Arrest of Suspected Cases.

A number of cases have occurred where "Enemy Aliens" have enlisted into the Canadian Expeditionary Force by means of misrepresenting themselves, that is, as Serbian or Roumanian subjects. This is undoubtedly a source of danger to the Force, and must be prevented.

The Department of Immigration has offered to place all the information which is in its possession at the disposal of Recruiting Officers in order to enable them to prevent enlistment of "Enemy Aliens."

All Recruiting Officers, will, therefore, submit any doubtful cases for enlistment, with regard to nationality, to the Department of Immigration, for investigation and report, and in doing so will furnish the following information for the guidance of that Department:

Exact name, age, date of arrival in Canada, name of port of arrival, whether Canadian or American, name of steamship, and date, if possible, of its arrival or date and port of its sailing.

It is pointed out, as a matter of information with reference to the question of alien nationality, that the Department of Immigration keeps a record of every immigrant entering Canada legally, showing name, age, citizenship, country of birth and address of relatives.

Furthermore, that Department states that there will be practically no delay in furnishing any such information.
