

NEW REGULATIONS

Will Not Effect The Guard At Fort Henry

Major P. G. C. Campbell, commandant of Fort Henry and in command of the 14th Regiment Guard does not think that the new regulations governing recruits for home service, that were published in the Whig last week, will have a material effect on the Guard. The physical requirements for recruits for the Guard are not as strict as for overseas volunteers by a special order issued some time ago and now every man who cares to join is taken on if he can stand the work. The work however is strenuous as it means eight hours a day standing up.

As recruits come in, Major Campbell is able to release others for overseas service and at regular intervals men are allowed to transfer to the Expeditionary Force unit.
