Eleven Austrians Arrested on Yonge Street Dock

Attracted by several peculiar-looking objects lying on the Yonge street dock late last night, Inspector Sauden, Acting Detective McConnell, and P. C. Waterhouse, discovered eleven Austrians asleep on the dock with their bundles of old clothes being used as pillows. The men were immediately taken in charge and marched up to Court street police station, where they are being held as **alien enemies**.
