

INTERNS RESUME WORK

St. Catharines, Ont., Aug. 15.—Interned aliens who refused to work last week on the new ship canal because they had been told by an educated Austrian that the British government would be obliged to pay them \$5 per day for their time spent in custody, yesterday returned to work. The men were released from barracks at Niagara Falls on orders from Ottawa, and sent back to Thorold. When confronted with arrest for vagrancy, their fines to be deducted from money held by the government, they decided for labor.
