

# **THE CAMP SOLDIERS HUNT FOR GERMANS**

## **The Escaped Prisoners From Fort Henry Thought to Be Near.**

Over 2,500 soldiers from Barrielfield camp are searching the river front for the two Germans who escaped from Fort Henry on Wednesday afternoon. They were called out Friday afternoon, as it is thought the escaped men are not far away. Major P. G. C. Campbell, in command of Fort Henry, has reported the escape to Gen. Otter, and an investigation will be held.

A report comes from the fort that the Germans dug themselves into the ground and remained there until after their guards passed and then made their escape.

The authorities are following up various clues, but so far have not been able to land the missing men.

A report on Friday morning stated that the two men had been seen out the Front Road, and as a result this district is being searched for the runaways.

One of the Germans is six feet, two inches in height, but although a regular giant in height, it is stated that he is very easily handled.
