

SUSPECT PLAN TO BLOW WALKERVILLE MUNITION PLANT UP

Believe Austrian Introduced
Explosive Chemical Into
Shell Varnish

Wakerville, Aug. 25.—An Austrian named Bjerich, was arrested last night at the Canadian Bridge Company's works here, suspected of planning an explosion, and it is believed a similar method blew up the ammunition works at New York harbor last month, when millions of dollars worth of the allies' munitions were destroyed. The system employed is to introduce into the varnish solution which is poured into the central bore of each shell, a chemical designed to cause an explosion after a limited period.
