

WANT AUSTRIAN'S RETURN

Fugitive in Leaky Boat Seven Hours

Niagara Falls, N.Y., Sept. 12.—The Canadian army officials have made a demand upon the United States immigration officials at this port for the return of George Zinko-

vick, 21 years old, an Austrian until Saturday under arrest at Niagara camp on a charge of being an enemy spy. Zinkovick, formerly attached to the 215th Battalion at Brantford has twice escaped from the authorities.

Suffering greatly from exposure and hunger, he was found adrift in Lake Ontario yesterday, in a scow and clad in only an undershirt. He had been on the lake seven hours in a leaky tub of a boat. He was brought ashore by Captain Wins-

low's life saving crew at Fort Niagara and turned over to the immigration authorities, who sent him to the Lockport county jail on a charge of attempting to enter the country without the customary examination. He says he was forced into the army under duress and further that he has three brothers fighting in the Austrian army.
