

TRADED WITH THE ENEMY

Man and Wife Fined One Hundred Dollars Each

Mr. and Mrs. Stanley Kanopoka, 540 Perth avenue, in General Sessions to-day were found guilty of trading with the enemy and were fined \$100 each with the alternative of spending three months in the Ontario Reformatory.

The prisoners admitted sending money to Austria, but contended that it had gone only to relatives in response to letters asking for financial aid. Counsel for the defence held that money sent to keep relatives from starving did not constitute a violation of the Act.
