

SETTLE COAL MINE CASE.

The suit of McLellan and Frey v. the Vancouver-Nanaimo Coal Company for the recovery of \$75,000 alleged to be due the plaintiffs on certain properties sold the company, has been settled out of court. When the suit was launched an application was made to put the plaintiffs out of court on the ground that one of them was an alien enemy, but the judge in chambers referred the whole matter to the trial judge. The settlement reached, it is understood, involves the return of the properties and certain other considerations.
