

## Objects to Greeks on Street Cars.

Ald. Sam McBride telephoned Ald. Joseph Gibbons to-day stating that one of the conductors of Manager Fleming's street cars, who collected a fare from fighting Sam last night, is a Greek. After reading the war news in the morning papers the alderman's feelings of indignation were aroused and he expressed himself as strongly opposed to Greeks collecting fares on the cars. He stated that he intended to bring the matter to the attention of the City Council at the next meeting and request that the Council ask Mr. Fleming to place returned soldiers on the cars instead of enemy aliens. Ald. Gibbons stated that with a little change in the construction of the cars it would be made quite convenient for returned soldiers to collect fares as the passengers enter the cars. Ald. McBride suggests that a conference be held between Commissioner Harris and Manager Fleming to see if more returned soldiers can be engaged on the cars.
