ALIENS OF ENEMY BIRTH ON PAROLE, MUST REPORT MOVEMENTS TO POLICE

That the military authorities are de-

termined that a stricter supervision shall be exercised regarding the movements of alien enemies resident in Canada, may be gathered from special instructions received from the Department at the Brandon police head-

quarters this morning.

The order apears to more specially apply to aliens of enemy nationality,

to who many certificate of parole has been issued. It stipulates that no such person shall quit any city or district without acquainting the chief officer of police of the fact, and stating the name of the locality to which

The circular received this morning draws special attention to the caluse which provides that any persons of

enemy nationality who do not observe

the requirements of the regulations shall be liable to a summary conviction under the Criminal Code by the imposition of a penalty of imprisonment for a term not to exceed six months, or a fine of not exceeding \$500.00, or both the imprisonment and fine.
