

CONVICTED OF SEDITION.

German Sympathizer in Manitoba Fined Seven Hundred Dollars.

Albert Manshrick, wealthy farmer of Deloraine, Man., has been convicted of ~~sedition~~ by the Court of Appeal, Winnipeg. He was fined \$700 by the judge, which he paid. Manshrick had said in conversation with neighbors that he hoped the Canadian soldiers would not return and made remarks praising the Germans for the Lusitania affair. The accused had said that a German invasion of Canada would be all right.
