

German Prisoner Escapes From Canadian Camp ?

Adrian, Mich., Dec. 15. — Half-starved and nearly perishing with cold, Otto Scheer, twenty-one years of age, a German sailor, who says he escaped from the Canadian internment camp near Quebec, sought shelter at North Morenci, a small station on the Wabash railroad, early this morning. He says he left Quebec in a box car, arriving at Windsor on Thursday afternoon, and crossed on the ferry to Detroit. He started to walk to Chicago, where he has relatives, he said.
