

WON'T NATURALIZE ENEMY ALIENS WITH WAR IN PROGRESS

246 Names Will Consequently
Be Taken Off Kitchener
Voters' Lists

Kitchener, Dec. 23.—The court of General Sessions here yesterday decided that aliens of enemy birth cannot be naturalized during the war. Two hundred and forty-six aliens on the voter's lists will consequently be struck off, and will not vote at the municipal elections. Some of them have been here from ten to thirty years, and few made any previous efforts to secure naturalization.
