ter, in his denunciation of the real spirit of "Canadians" of alien extraction. He urged that Canada should be on her guard against men posing as true Britishers, men with a German name, German parents, and German

birth. "The do as the Romans do in Rome," he said, "but their hearts are not with Rome and her cause. They do as Can-

adians do in Canada, they talk pro-Canada and anti-German, in pro-Canada and anti-German company, but the majority of them can stand careful watching."
