TO LOOK AFTER GERMANS IN  
FOR HENRY.

Americans in Canadian Army May  
Seek Transfer if the United States  
Declares War on Germany.

"Will Americans who are enlisted in units of the Canadian Expeditionary force be released to serve with the United States army should that country declare war on Germany?" is a question that many Americans have been putting to American Consul Johnston. They are threatening to desert if the United States organized an army for itself.

The question of "what is the United States going to do?" is causing a great amount of anxiety not only among the soldiers, but among civilians. Mr. Johnston expressed the opinion on Monday that he thought it possible that parcels to prisoners in Germany could still be sent through this office and then through the Spanish Embassy to Germany.

The German prisoners of war at Fort Henry will be looked after by the Consul-General of Sweden at Montreal, who, it is said, is a very clever and popular official. Parcels to the prisoners from their American friends will now be sent to that official.
