

50 Unregistered Bulgarians Found By Welland Chief

Welland, Ont., March 14.—Chief of Police Laing, who has taken over the charge of paroled aliens in Welland, states that he has found here a colony of fifty Bulgarians who have never been on parole. On Friday he arrested Nick Zagvozki, who came to Welland from Montreal. It was found that he had previously broken parole and had for that offense been for a year and a half in an internment camp. He was fined \$100 and costs or 6 mos. in jail.

Joseph Furman, an Austrian, also charged with violating his parole, was fined \$25 and costs.

Steve Murda, arrested by Officer Kotesniko, was fined \$10 and costs for being drunk.
