TORONTO RETURNED SOLDIERS WANT ALIEN ENEMIES INTERNED Toronto, April 18. — Mayor Church

and Chief of Police Grasset last evening met representatives of the war veterans with a view of settling the grievances regarding anen enemies, which have led to the recent raids on restaurants and factories. Capt Sinclair, provost-marchal of the city, and Capt. Windgery, of Exhibition camp, were present. The returned soldiers asked that steps be taken to prevent the importation of enemy alien labor and their employment in public works, and declared for their internment. They also ask for a civic bureau for the benefit of the returned men. The mayor promised to take the

matter up with Ottawa and the civic authorities. In the meanwhile a brief

truce was agreed to.
