

VETERANS FAVOR ALIEN BARRIER

Heroes of Great War Indorse Resolutions Drafted At Recent Convention

Virtually every resolution adopted by the national conference while in session here several days ago, was indorsed by members of the local Great War Veterans' association at a general meeting Thursday night.

The meeting was the largest yet held by the Great War Veterans. More than 300 members attended. The vote upon the indorsation of the convention's resolution was unanimous.

The resolutions adopted provided for the following:

The disenfranchisement of aliens; the sequestration of alien lands; compulsory service; employment of returned soldiers in federal and provincial civil service; taxation of excess war profits; the discharge of alien enemies from the employ of the government; the regulating of pensions, minimum for total disability to be \$1,200; and the discharge of munition workers for overseas service; their places to be filled with returned soldiers.

The members approved of the appointment of N. F. R. Knight, of Windsor, to the post of Dominion secretary at a salary of \$150 a month.
