

FIXING UP COURT HOUSE FOR USE OF THE CITY POLICE

Force Expects to Move in
the Early Part of
Next Week

The work of redecorating part of the Court House building for use by the city police force, has almost been completed. The work will be finished this week and in all probability the Police Department will take possession in the early part of next week.

The ground floor rooms, which were formerly used as an office on the one side and toilet rooms on the other, have both been cleaned up and painted and now both down stair rooms will be occupied as offices. The cell corridor and two sets of cells, providing accommodation for at least nine prisoners have also been newly painted and cleaned. These are also on the ground floor in the rear of the offices.

The new quarters will make things very much more satisfactory for the operation of the Police Department and much more sanitary than the present premises occupied in the city hall and the court room will be more commodious for handling the crowd which usually fills Magistrate Elliott's court, which of course is chiefly foreigners.
