

INTERNEED BUT UNTAMED

German Prisoner Arraigned at Vernon For Using Seditious Language.

VERNON, B. C., Nov. 30.—A German prisoner in the internment camp here, who gave his name as Joe Lee, was committed for trial by Police Magistrate Heggie on a charge of using seditious language, and his case will be heard at the next session of the county court. Several of the military guards gave evidence that he had employed foul, obscene and abusive terms in referring to the king and the British people.
