After Several Months' Service
With An Artillery Unit.**

Mr. W. J. McMurtry, 403 Huron street, has received word that his son, Pte. Roy F. McMurtry, has been missing since Nov. 6. At the outbreak of war he was in the employ of the Calgary branch of the Trusts and Guarantee Company. For some time he acted as

guard at an internment camp, later enlisting as a sergeant with the 135th Battalion of Calgary. When the battalion was broken up in England he gave up his stripes in order to get to the front. Pte.
