With reference to the attached Report to Council submitting an amendment to paragraph 51 of the Defence of Canada Order, I beg to state that the amendment in question is recommended by the Justice Department.


As it now stands paragraph 51 reads as follows:-

Any person contravening any of the provisions of this Order shall be liable to a penalty not exceeding Five Thousand Dollars or imprisonment for any term not exceeding five years or to both fine and imprisonment; any such penalty may be recovered or enforced by summary proceedings and conviction under the provisions of Part 15 of the Criminal Code.

Justice Department have recommended that the following words should be inserted between "Order", and "shall" in the first line:-

Or of any rule or regulation competently sanctioned to provide for or regulate any of the matters herein provided to be regulated.
