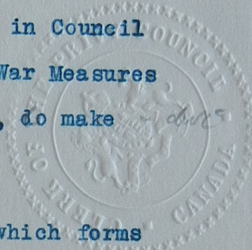

TO HIS EXCELLENCY

THE GOVERNOR GENERAL IN COUNCIL:-

The undersigned begs to recommend that His Excellency the Governor General in Council under and by virtue of Section 6 of the War Measures Act, and any other power in him residing, do make the following Regulation:-



The statutory declaration, which forms a part of Schedule "B", to Order in Council P.C.1433, of 24th day of May, 1917, concerning the departure out of Canada of male persons who are liable to or capable of national service of a military or other character, may be made before any person who by the law of the Province wherein such declaration is made has power to administer an oath, or before any officer or employee of the Immigration Branch of the Department of Interior.
