The undersigned has had under consideration the Minute of Council of the 5th October, 1906, -P.C.No.3353- which approved the Treasury Board recommendation, -"That "all recommendations to Council with relation to the "appointment, employment or continuance of employment, "promotion, increase or reduction of salary or pay, "granting or extension of leave of absence or payment "of travelling expenses of any employee or proposed em- "ployee of the Government, either permanent or temporary, "be referred to the Treasury Board for consideration and "report, before being finally dealt with by Council".

The undersigned, -in order to relieve the Cabinet of as much almost purely routine business as possible, - (recommends that) the following recommendations from the various Departments, be (also) referred to the Treasury Board for consideration and report, before being finally dealt with by Council:-
