

CONSCRIPT ALIEN LABOR

Fruit Growers Want Government to Deal With Enemies and Orientals

VERNON, B. C. Jan. 9.—At a meeting of the North and South Vernon Branches of the B. C. Fruit Growers Association held last evening, the following resolution dealing with oriental and other alien labor was passed.

"That this meeting is in favor of any resolution at the forthcoming convention looking toward the conscription of alien labor, and the regulation of oriental labor, whether to be introduction of indentured labor or otherwise.
