

# WANT TO EJECT ALL ALIENS FROM FACTORIES

TORONTO, Feb. 28.—The central branch of the G.W.V.A. held a stormy meeting, last evening, the "bone of contention" being the alien labor question.

Many of the members were for forcibly removing all aliens from factories in Toronto, and discussion on this point waxed hot. Lieut.-Col. E. B. Hardy, D.S.O., president of the branch, counselled caution and advised the men to use all the peaceful means possible before resorting to force.

"The Government is watching the G.W.V.A.," said Col. Hardy, "and Bolsheviki tactics, will do us no good."

The meeting finally resulted in the passing of a motion for calling of a mass meeting of all other returned soldiers to Toronto for Tuesday or Wednesday of next week, when the whole matter will be threshed out.
