

# AUSTRIANS ARE SENT TO INTERNMENT CAMP

John Rexum and Eli Moskuluk, two Austrians arraigned in Police Court this morning on a charge of refusing to show their parole papers to a Dominion Police officer for inspection, were found guilty and were ordered to be interned.

In finding them guilty Magistrate Askwith declared that such offences have to be dealt with severely and at first it was his intention to impose a fine of \$150 each, but he decided that internment would be the better way of disposing of them.

They were arrested in a Hull bar-room by Dominion Police Officer A. E. Reynolds.
