

LOGIE BIDS GOOD-BYE TO HIS STAFF OFFICERS

Col. H. C. Bickford Takes Over Duties of Commander of This Military District.

It was farewell day at military headquarters, Major-General W. A. Logie, general officer commanding the district who has been in command for three strenuous years, stepped out at noon to-day and handed over the reins to Col. H. C. Bickford.

Following the daily noon-hour conference with headquarters staff officers, General Logie said good-bye to his staff who have worked with him for the past three years in the largest military administrative command in Canada. To-night General Logie will go to Ottawa to confer with the military authorities, and will then shortly leave for overseas on a special mission, which will be announced at a future date by the Minister of Militia.
