

TOO MUCH LATITUDE IS GIVEN THE ALIENS

TORONTO, April 4.—Speaking at a complimentary dinner tendered Mr. A. M. Adams, local freight agent of the Grand Trunk Railway by the Toronto branch of the International Brotherhood of Railway Stationmen and Railway Employees' Alliance of America last night, his worship, Mayor Church roundly condemned the Union Government for the latitude afforded alien enemies in Canada. The Mayor did not approve of the way in which the Union Government had undertaken the task of dealing with some matters of vast importance to the people of Canada. There was altogether too much rule by commissions and orders—in-council.

Referring to the outbreak of hostilities in Quebec, the Mayor attributed the trouble to the latitude allowed alien enemies in Canada, in which a certain element had endeavored to promote treason and sedition.

The Mayor predicted a hopeful future for the labor political party provided the workers were careful to rid their ranks of the Socialistic element which had been responsible for the downfall of Russia at a crucial stage in the war.
