BORDER CLOSED TO ALIEN WOMEN

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Cannot Leave U. S. Without Passports-Americans of **Draft Age Require Permit**

(Special Despatch to The Globe.) Detroit, May 8 .--- Chief Immigration Inspector Frick, in charge of United States immigrant service at this point, to-day ordered the United. States-Canadian border closed to all enemy alien women more than fourteen years of age and to all American men of draft age. This was in accordance with orders from the Department of Justice at Washington. The alfen women must obtain per-mission from this department, and must be provided with passports beand leave fore they can the United States. As this procedure will re-quire two weeks or more, it means that hundreds of young women employed in munitions plants and other industries across the river will not be able to go to work to-morrow morn-ing. The order becomes effective at once, and late this afternoon many women were held up.

Americans of draft age will be: Americans of draft age will be permitted to cross into Canada only with written permission from their Draft Boards. One young man who came from Mount Clemens this afternoon to go to Chatham to see his dying mother was sent back to Mount Clemens for this permission.
