

GARRISON REGIMENT OFFICERS ARE NAMED

Lieut.-Col. Cooper to be O. C. —Headquarters Here.

VICTORIA, June 5—Announcement is made by Major-General Leckie this morning concerning the appointments in connection with the 11th Battalion, Canadian Garrison Regiment, which absorbs the various militia units in British Columbia under the jurisdiction of the general officer commanding M. D. 11.

The commanding officer of the regiment is to be Lieut.Col. R. C. Cooper, better known to the general public as Major Cooper, M. P., with headquarters and one company permanently established at Vancouver.

Major R. E. Monteith has been appointed to the post of second in command of the regiment and Capt. Underhill as adjutant.

Capt. A. E. Jukes will command one of the companies with the rank of major. Another company is to be allotted to Major G. Anderson, and it is expected that the fourth company will go to the command of Major Leduc, the later appointment, however, awaits confirmation from Ottawa. Captain W. R. Barlee will be posted to second in command of one of the companies and the balance of the appointments in connection with the officering of the regiments will be announced by General Leckie later.

According to present instructions the four companies of the regiment will be posted as follows: One company in Victoria; one at Vancouver (headquarters company); one at Vernon and the other at Morrissey. The duties of the two last-named companies will be largely taken up in connection with the internment camps of the interior.
