

SPIES LOOSE IN HALIFAX

Herald Conducts a Vigorous Campaign To Have All Enemy Aliens Rounded Up.

Halifax, July 6.—Since the sinking of the hospital ship Llandovery Castle, The Halifax Herald has been carrying on a vigorous editorial campaign against **enemy aliens**, who have been enjoying the freedom of the city since the outbreak of the war. **Enemy aliens**, The Herald alleges, who have no regular occupations, are in constant association with sailors and soldiers, watching marine movements.

At a meeting of the Board of Control it was decided to wait on the military authorities and urge the rounding up and internment of all **enemy aliens**.
