Evader, Proved To Be German, Is Interned

A German birth certificate, a German police certificate, names of prominent Germans in the United States and South America, found in the possession of Werner Vent, alias Barahona, resulted in his removal Wednesday to the internment camp at Kupas Kasing, Ont.

He had been arrested by the Dominion police here as a draft evader. A search of his room at 599 Bannerman ave. resulted in the discovery that he is a German, born at Hamburg 33 years ago. During 1914-15 he was employed by the Standard Trust company, Saskatoon, and since then has been working on Canadian Northern railway dining cars, his papers showed.
