

## RUTHENIANS MAY FORM ORTHODOX CHURCH

---

Declare Themselves Loyal Canadians  
—Support Public Schools.

Saskatoon, July 24.—A number of representatives of the dissatisfied elements in the Ruthenian Greek Catholic Church are in conference, and the probable outcome of their deliberations will be the formation of a Ruthenian Greek Orthodox Church. There is considerable discontent in the Greek Catholic Church over the actions of Bishop Budka, head of the Church in Canada, whose avowed object is the assimilation of the Ruthenian Greek Catholics with the French-Canadians.

No question of the assimilation of the Ruthenian race into Canadian nationality, as stated by a Canadian Press despatch a couple of days ago, enters into the conference. \* The representatives here are strongly supporting the public schools and declare they are loyal Canadians. It is not likely that there will be formal steps taken toward the formation of the new Church at this conference.
