

## JUSTICE MONET ORDERS

## FOREIGNERS RELEASED.

Montreal, Aug. 6.—Holding that the Parliament of Canada does not possess the power to suspend the Habeas Corpus Act or delegate the power of suspension to the Governor-General-in-Council, Mr. Justice Monet today ordered the military authorities to release two youths of foreign birth, Blanshay and Strulovith, both now being held for military service. The judge held that as these men had no vote at the last elections they cannot be called on for military duty.
