Speaking to The Globe just before his departure last night, he said:

I have been asked by the New York National Herald, the leading Greek publication in America, to visit Toronto and investigate the situation regarding the recent unfortunate events against the Greek restaurants. Before leaving the Queen City, I wish to make a statement, with the hope that it may lead up to a befter understanding between that section of the Canadian public which is dissatisfied with the Greeks, and those who have suffered as a result of this dissatisfied with the Greeks, and those who have suffered as a result of this dissatisfied with the Greeks, and those who have suffered as a result of and they both have assured me that the Greek population of Toronto is a very law-abiding element, and that their conduct has been satisfactory. The riots were a result of a misunderstanding, which, according to Mayor Church-resulted by the failure of the Canadian Government to settle the question of allied and neutral allens in the Dominion.

It has been stated in some of the local papers that I have said pro-German Greeks are behind these riots. All I have stated in this direction is that there is a certain element both in the States and Canada, who call themselves Greeks, and who are not really Greeks. They really belong to other Balkan nationalities enemy to the allied cause, and this element is pro-German. They, of course, delight most heartily in these riots. No true Greek is a pro-German to-day, because Germans are as much the Greece as they are the Canada.

Nowhere have I met with an element so willing and ready to do their duty both by their adopted country, Canada, and their mother country, Greece. I had the pleasure of addressing them in the Greek Church yesterday, and I have watched their eager looks and heard their solemn determination to prove true sons of Greece and loyal citizens of Canada.

The President of their community here assured me that they are willing and ready to share to a fuller and greater measure the spirit of sacrifice which the Canadian people have so gloriously exhibited in this war.

"We are ready to do anything the city of Toronto and the Dominion of Canada wishes us to do. Those who are Canadian citizens have either enlisted with the Canadian army or are awaiting their orders to don the King's uniform and go to the front and fight with their Canadian brothers under the Union Jack. Those who are still Greek cilizens are awaiting only too anxiously for better transportation to go to the Macconian front and join their brothers who are now lighting with the allies against the common fee. While we stay in Toronto we are ready and worthy of the great privileges we have enjoyed in this beautiful country of Canada."

In closing I wish to state once more that we, the Greeks throughout the length and breadth of the world, are one with you Canadians and our common allies, in this, our war.
