Austrian Sentenced To Internment Camp

Sarnia, August 13.—For having failed to register or to carry papers of any kind, John Dribble, an Austrian, who was taken off the steamer Huronic two weeks ago, has been sentenced to an internment camp for the duration of the war.

He first claimed to be a French-Canadian, but later admitted that he was a Galician. Ottawa was communicated with, and he will probably go to Niagara.
