

ELEVATOR EMPLOYEES MAY STRIKE AGAIN

Men Are Asking For 60 Cents
An Hour Instead
of 40

Fort William, Ont., Aug. 26.—The possibility of a recurrence of the strike among employes of elevators at the head of the lakes is being seriously discussed by the operators of elevators here. The agreement entered into October 10 last year expires September 1 and the men now are asking for sixty cents an hour, instead of forty cents awarded last year, with time and a half for over time and double pay on Sundays and statutory holidays. It is hoped that some settlement may be arrived at during the coming week, but one man connected with the elevator management stated today that great objection was raised to the number of alien enemies who will participate in the proposed scale which would mean \$12 a day for every Sunday till the close of navigation.
