

DIED AT KAPEESKASING

Pte. J. H. Huise Victim of Influenza at Internment Camp

An instance of the far-reaching effects of the influenza epidemic was furnished yesterday, when Mr. T. F. Hannan, of 70 St. Matthew

street, received a telegram stating that his nephew, Pte. John Henry Hulse, had died at Kapuskasing camp of pneumonia, following influenza, on Sunday morning. Pte. Hulse had been reared by Mr. Hannan. He joined the forces several years ago, and was detailed from Toronto for service at the internment camp for alien enemies. His remains have been sent to Toronto, where his mother resides, and a military funeral will be held there on Thursday. Mr. and Mrs. Hannan will leave this evening for Toronto to attend the funeral.
