

WOULD SEND ALIENS HOME

Vernon Veterans Urge Authorities to Deport Interned Enemies.

VERNON, B. C., Dec. 13.—At the monthly meeting of the Great War Veterans' Association resolutions were passed urging that all alien enemies in internment camps be deported to their home countries as early as possible, and urging that punishment be inflicted on the former emperor of Germany for his crimes against humanity.

The association went on record with an earnest request that the federal and provincial governments take the necessary steps at an early date to commence construction of the Canadian Northern Railway branch line from Kamloops to Kelowna, with spur to Lumby. It was pointed out that the land which would be opened for development by the construction of this line would be most desirable for settlement by veterans.
