THE GOVERNOR GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

WHEREAS by Order in Council (P. C. 2731) dated 3rd October, 1917, issued under the provisions of the War Measures Act, the Secretary of State of Canada was authorized to issue a License to the Canadian Branches of Thomas Cook & Son, of London, England, to transmit to British, allied or neutral subjects in enemy-occupied territory, for their maintenance, any sum not exceeding twenty-five pounds per month in the case of any one individual transaction, and ~~that~~ on the 24th day of January, 1918, an Order in Council was passed, (P. C. 199), authorizing the Secretary of State to issue Licenses under which payments might be made to persons, firms or corporations residing and carrying on business in Canada, and in allied or neutral countries, of sums on behalf of enemies, as defined by the Consolidated Orders respecting Trading with the Enemy, and to carry

out such financial transactions as might be advisable and necessary for the purpose of protecting property or securities held or situate in Canada.

AND WHEREAS the development of the War and the changed conditions in Russia necessitates provisions for general Licenses for the transmission of money to enemy and enemy-occupied territory, and for the purpose of enabling persons residing in Canada to enter into communication with persons in enemy-occupied territory, and for the purpose of authorizing payments in Canada of sums for the benefit of an enemy;

THEREFORE, His Excellency the Governor General in Council, on the recommendation of the Secretary of State, and under the provisions of the War Measures Act, 1914, is pleased to authorize and doth hereby authorize the Secretary of State of Canada to grant Licenses permitting the transmission of money to enemies, allies and neutrals in enemy or enemy-occupied territory, to authorize communication or intercourse with enemies or persons in enemy or enemy-occupied territory, to authorize the expenditure of moneys in Canada on behalf of or for the benefit of enemies or persons in enemy-occupied territory, and to carry out such financial transactions as may be advisable and necessary for the purpose of protecting property or securities held or situate in Canada;

AND

AND, His Excellency the Governor General in Council, is further pleased to order and doth hereby order that the Orders in Council aforesaid, of the 3rd of October, 1917, (P. C. 2731) and (P.C.199) of the 24th day of January, 1918, shall be and the same are hereby revoked; Provided, however, that such revocation of said Orders in Council shall not:-

(a) affect the previous operation of the Orders so revoked or anything duly done or suffered thereunder;

(b) affect any right, privilege, obligation or liability acquired, accrued or incurred under the said Orders;

(c) affect any penalty, forfeiture or punishment incurred in respect of any offence committed against the said Orders, or

(d) affect any proceedings or remedy in respect of any right, privilege, obligation, liability, penalty, forfeiture or punishment aforesaid; and any permission or direction given or order or requirement made or other action taken under the said Orders so revoked shall be deemed to have been given, made or taken under this Order.
