



The Committee of the Privy Council have had before them a memorandum, dated 24th July, 1918, from the Minister of Justice, reporting that Major-General Sir W. D. Otter has applied for a further advance on account of expenses of internment of prisoners of War, and has furnished the statement herewith submitted to account for the expenditure of advances previously made.

The Committee, on the recommendation of the Minister of Justice, advise that authority be granted for an advance of \$50,000.00 to Major-General Sir W. D. Otter, to be charged against the War Appropriation, 1918-19, the same to be expended under and subject to the provisions of the Order in Council of the 8th May, 1915, establishing the War Purchasing Commission.
