MEMORANDUM to the Acting Minister of Trade and Commerce.

It has been considered advisable to follow as closely as possible the action of the British Board of Trade in respect of Patents, Trade Marks and Designs in so far as the enemy is concerned.

Pursuant to this policy the license referred to in attached report to Council was granted in the terms of two licences of the British Board of Trade, published in the London Gazette on the 14th of December, '15 and the 5th of September, '17. The later being an amendment of the earlier.

The Colonial Secretary has cabled that the two British licenses have been revoked; hence this report to Council.
