THE GOVERNOR GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

WHEREAS by Order in Council of date the 23rd October, 1917, a license in connection with the Royal Proclamations relating to Trading with the Enemy was granted, permitting in certain circumstances the payment of fees and Agents' charges, and the expenses in respect of Patents, Trade Marks and Designs, payable in an enemy country or on behalf of an enemy;

AND WHEREAS it has been deemed desirable to revoke said license;

THEREFORE, His Excellency the Governor General in Council, on the recommendation of the Acting Minister of Trade and Commerce, is pleased to revoke and doth hereby revoke the said license.
