

WILL STOP INDUSTRY TO GET RID OF ALIENS

Returned Soldiers at Winnipeg Launch Criticism at Dominion Government.

Winnipeg, Jan. 31.—Criticism of the Dominion Government for not having an absorption scheme ready, a demand upon the employers for work, not as charity, but as a square deal, and a demand that alien enemies should be cleared out of Canada, were the dominant features of the speeches at a meeting under the auspices of the Returned Soldiers' Association and the Next-of-Kin Association here last night.

The statement that if the deportation of the aliens meant the stopping of every wheel in Canada they should be let stop, was cheered to the echo by the audience of between two and three thousand.
